

IF YOU ARE BEING QUESTIONED BY POLICE, **KNOW YOUR RIGHTS**

- **IF YOU ARE ARRESTED, ASK FOR A LAWYER.**
- **DO NOT GIVE PERMISSION FOR OR CONSENT TO A SEARCH** of your person, belongings, car, or home.
- Although not required by law, carrying proper ID can help with police encounters.
- Phone calls from prison facilities are recorded. **DO NOT SPEAK ABOUT YOUR CASE.**

YOU WILL BE PROVIDED WITH A MIRANDA WARNING

MIRANDA WARNING

- You have the right to remain silent.
- Anything you say can and will be used against you in a court of law.
- You have the right to talk to a lawyer and have him present with you while you are being questioned.
- If you cannot afford to hire a lawyer, one will be appointed to represent you before any questioning if you wish.
- You can decide at any time to exercise these rights and not answer any questions or make any statements.

WAIVER

- Do you understand each of these rights I have explained to you?
- Having these rights in mind, do you wish to talk to us now?
